NEW BUSINESS

Attorney Tim Stranko presented to council his recent review and analysis of the Elkins City Charter. The charter is something that only belongs to the city. Mr. Stranko highlighted the importance of choosing one of the five models identified in W.Va. Code to align with other city structures, professional organizations and existing case law. Mr. Stranko presented each of these existing models with the aid of a power point presentation, and then ran each model through the filter of what he identified as criteria important to a high functioning, inclusive government. He asked that during this exercise council consider these as objectively as possible, absent current elected or appointed officials or past experiences, and think of everyone involved as rational actors. Immediately following the presentation, council held an open discussion and directed questions to Mr. Stranko. No action was taken, except to ask Mr. Stanko to investigate the

salaries and tenure of city managers in comparable cities. This information will be provided to the Clerk to share with council prior to the next meeting. Further, council will resume discussion of this item at the meeting of August 20, 2020.

Sutton Stokes also previewed the information available on the city's website relating to changes to the charter.
