# ELKINS COMMON COUNCIL PUBLIC HEARING MINUTES

#### **NEW BUSINESS**

City charter review and discussion continued. The Clerk reviewed a memo issued to council describing what the Clerk and Mr. Stranko understood to be the difference between items that

have council consensus and public approval and those that do not have counsel consensus or a known objection from the public. Mr. Stranko advised of two options most likely for council to pursue. The first is passing by ordinance the non-controversial items and moving the objectionable items to the ballot as set out in W.Va. Code § 8-4-8. The second as described in W. Va. Code §8-4-7 would require a referendum to proceed to be put before the public, the creation of a charter board and then a ballot of the proposed charter amendments. Mr. Stranko advised council the first option may be the better choice considering the work they've already done and is less expensive for the city. There was no discussion of the charter content. Councilors Friddle, Wilmoth, Vest, Hinchman and Chenoweth all expressed interest in having more time to review the proposal and suggested a special call meeting for further discussion.

Cw. Guye, moved approval of Ordinance 273: ordinance authorizing the acquisition and construction of certain extensions, additions, betterments and improvements to the existing public sewerage system of the city of elkins and the financing of the cost thereof, not otherwise provided, through the issuance by the city of elkins of not more than \$4,964,800 in original aggregate principal amount of sewer revenue bonds, series 2020 a (west virginia srf program); providing for the rights and remedies of and security for the registered owners of such bonds; authorizing execution and delivery of all documents relating to the issuance of such bonds; approving a loan agreement relating to such bonds; authorizing the sale and providing for the terms and provisions of such bonds and adopting other provisions relating thereto (3rd and final reading).
