# ELKINS COMMON COUNCIL REGULAR COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES

401 Davis Avenue Council Chamber, 2nd Floor October 1, 2020 7:00 p.m.

Elkins Common Council met in regular session in the council chamber of city hall. Present were Mayor Van T. Broughton; Councilpersons R.C. Chenoweth, M. D. Cuonzo, C.H. Friddle, III, G.M. Hinchman, , C. L. Metheny, D.C. Parker, L.H. Vest, and K.L. Wilmoth; City Treasurer T. Judy; Fire Chief T. W. Meader; Police Chief T. Bennett; City Attorney G. S. Roberts; City Clerk J.R. Sutton (acting as recording secretary); and Inter-Mountain Reporter A. Gaynor.

Councilpersons J.A. Guye and C.C. Lowther and Operations Manager R.P. Pingley were absent.

The Mayor recognized residents of the West Virginia Children's Home and thanked them for attending.

### **PUBLIC COMMENT**

Mark Doak – resident of Beverly, but owner of multiple properties in downtown Elkins – previously submitted a written public comment in support of the mayor-manager form of government. He still supports the city switching to this. Mr. Doak is also a member of Envision Elkins, a group of approximately fifty downtown property and business owners, who are almost wholly in favor of moving to the mayor-manager form as well. One member is in support of the strong mayor system. The only concern the group has identified is in how the criteria for the position would be established and how an individual would be chosen.

Madalyn Humphrey, 639 Capital Street, appearing as the Elkins Main Street Director to announce the organization's move from their current location on Davis Avenue to the Randolph County Development Authority building on 11<sup>th</sup> Street effective October 15<sup>th</sup>. She will be housed with other community partners, but also intends on visiting the downtown frequently.

Bill from the West Virginia Children's Home asked to speak relating to an item not on the agenda. However, the mayor requested that he contact the Police Chief the following day instead. He agreed.

At the request of the chair, the City Clerk led a review of the most recent version of the draft charter, dated August 31, 2020. Council and administrative officers discussed each section of the draft and the Clerk noted any suggested changes. The Clerk also reminded council of the options to proceed with adoption by ordinance and/or election. Council was in general agreement on most matters except for section 1.04, Form of Government, and Section 2.09 Standing Committees.

Cm. Friddle, MOVED APPROVAL OF THE INCLUSION OF THE MAYOR-MANAGER FORM OF GOVERNMENT IN SECTION 1.04 OF THE CHARTER DRAFT. Cm. Metheny, MOVED TO POSTPONE UNTIL THE MEETING OF OCTOBER 15, 2020.
