Elkins Common Council met in special session at the Phil Gainer Community Center. Present were Mayor Van T. Broughton; Councilpersons R.C. Chenoweth, M. D. Cuonzo, C.H. Friddle, III, G.M. Hinchman, C. L. Metheny, D.C. Parker, L.H. Vest, and K.L. Wilmoth; City Treasurer T. Judy; Fire Chief T. W. Meader; Police Chief T. Bennett; Operations Manager R.P. Pingley; City Attorney G. S. Roberts; City Clerk J.R. Sutton (acting as recording secretary); and Inter-Mountain Reporter B. Johnson.

Councilpersons J.A. Guye and C.C. Lowther were absent.

PRESENTATION

Cm. D. Parker, chair of the Public Safety Committee, shared some remarks about the bravery shown by Elkins Police Department Officers, members of the Elkins Fire Department and employees of the Sanitation Department during recent events. Mr. Parker also shared his admiration for all the hard work and dedication displayed by City of Elkins employees daily.

Police Chief T. Bennett called forth Sr. Ptlm. K. Shiflett and Ptlm. 1st Class W. Butcher. Each were awarded formal commendations for their actions in helping to prevent a child from being drowned. The Chief then remarked on the events during which Ptlm. 1st Class D. Sayre was shot in the line of duty. Sayre was called forth and awarded the purple heart medal for his bravery.

Fire Chief T. Meader detailed the recent fire which resulted in two fatalities. The Chief recognized the members of the department as well as the EPD, Beverly Fire Department and the Emergency Squad for their involvement. He believes they went above and beyond the call of duty.
